

CRMR Summer Camp Curriculum 2019



Day 1: Aloha

Campers will feel welcome in the spirit of aloha, know we are invited to this place, recognize the gift of being at camp, and that the table is filled with people who are different. (Luke 14:15-24)

Day 2: Ubuntu

Campers will recognize value in themselves and others as children of God, know we are interwoven members of the Body of Christ, commit to nurture our camp community and experience ubuntu through shared joys and challenges. (1 Corinthians 12:1-27)

Day 3: Shalom

Campers will understand that conflict happens in all communities, acknowledge the truth that conflict can lead to brokenness, learn that we can move from brokenness to shalom, and understand that peace requires effort and happens over time. (Genesis 27:1-26)

Day 4: Agape

Campers will discover agape, God's great love, for us, come to believe that God's peace with us can be seen in Jesus' sacrificial love, and come to follow Jesus' example as a humble servant. (John 13:1-17)

Day 5: Heiwa

Campers will recognize that we are called to respect ourselves as children of God, learn that every person deserves our love and respect, discover that our love of others isn't dependent on anything in return, and experience heiwa as we practice peace over competition. (Mark 12:28-31)

Day 6: Si Se Puede

Campers will learn the importance of si se puede, putting our love for others into action, hear God's call to work together to do good in the world, and discover that being part of Christ's body empowers us to take risks as peacemakers. (Luke 10:25-37)
